Dear Resident,

Spring is on its way. This means that soon, our Town crews will begin collecting yard debris in your neighborhood.

Over the years the Town has worked to make this program as convenient for you as possible. You can learn more about this service from the Town website, at www.townofpittsford.org. The “Services” tab will take you to guidelines for Yard Debris pickup. It lists street names by service quadrant, so you can see the day of the week when we’ll collect debris from your street.

Once leaf collection season begins in mid-October you can plan ahead by using our online **Leaf App**, also under the website’s “Services” tab. It offers a live link that shows where crews are picking up leaves at that moment and where they’ll be going next.

Your experience with our Town services and your comments and advice about them are critical to the Town administration’s continuous efforts to improve. If you have advice or questions, please contact me at the number shown below. A very happy spring and summer to you all!

- **Loose Brush & Branch Collection**
May 2 – October 6
- **Bagged & Containerized Collection**
April 25 – November 17
- **Leaf Collection**
October 17 – December 2

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- There will be no collection on Memorial Day, Labor Day and Thanksgiving Day. Schedules will shift by one day following the holiday.
- Yard debris must be out by 6AM on your scheduled day to ensure proper collection.
- If you live on a private drive, please take materials to the nearest public street.
- Our schedule may vary slightly due to weather conditions and volume of debris. We appreciate your patience.
- Yard debris generated by anyone other than the homeowner must be removed as part of their service. This material may be taken to Pittsford's Highway Department, 60 Golf Avenue, weekdays from 7AM to 3:30PM.
- Please place yard debris *behind* the curb or gutter to avoid impeding traffic and blocking drainage pathways in your neighborhood.

Early Spring Cleanup: April 4 – April 29

Loose piles of leaves, thatch, brush, branches and yard debris will be collected. Please note crews will pick up both loose debris and/or containerized debris during this time. **See map for your weekly pickup day.**



Loose Brush and Branches: May 2 – October 6

- Brush and branches may be put in loose piles at the road edge **behind** the curb or gutter.
- Cuttings placed in loose piles must be less than 8 feet in length and less than 8 inches in diameter.
- See map for your weekly pickup day. All brush and branches must be containerized or bundled beginning the week of October 10.



Bagged/Containerized: April 25 – November 17

- Please use paper bags or reusable containers. Composting sites do not accept plastic bags.
- Grass clippings, weeds, ivy, vines and smaller yard debris must be placed in a container or bag.
- Total container weight, including yard debris, must be 50 pounds or less per container.
- Cuttings must be less than 3 feet in length and tied in bundles.
- **Please don't include** sod, stumps, rocks, stones, lumber, metal or other waste materials in with debris.
- All collection will end on your weekly yard debris pickup day (see map).



Leaf Collection: October 17 – December 2


- Crews will be in your neighborhood approximately every two weeks to collect loose leaf piles; **see the online Leaf Collection App for the real-time schedule.**
- For traffic safety and to avoid drain blockage and flooding, please place leaf piles at the road edge but **behind** the curb or gutter.
- **Please keep yard debris separate from leaves** – it can damage our leaf vacuum and injure our crew members.
- Only yard debris placed in a container or paper bag will continue to be collected on your weekly yard debris pickup day during this time.
- Loose brush will not be picked up during this time.



Yard Debris Collection Areas

Pickup Day:

- Monday (Blue)
- Tuesday (Green)
- Wednesday (Yellow)
- Thursday (Red)
